New Jersey law prohibits entities operating in certain regulated industries (financial institutions, insurance companies, utilities) from contributing. Election Law allows contributions with a limit of \$5,200 per candidate, per election cycle from individuals and corporations (\$20,800 total) and \$16,400 per candidate, per election from PAC's (\$65,600 total)

A partnership or limited liability company may not contribute as an entity. However, a check from a partnership or limited liability company may be accepted so long as it is accompanied by a letter allocating the contribution to the individual partner(s) or member(s) and is signed by each contributing partner or member. The letter must include each contributing partner's home address. A partner's total contribution, through the partnership and personally, cannot exceed the \$5,200 per candidate, per election cycle limit.

Political contributions are not deductible for income tax purposes. Contributions over \$200 are reportable with NJ ELEC.
